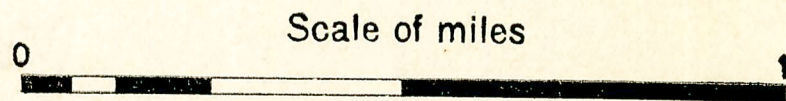
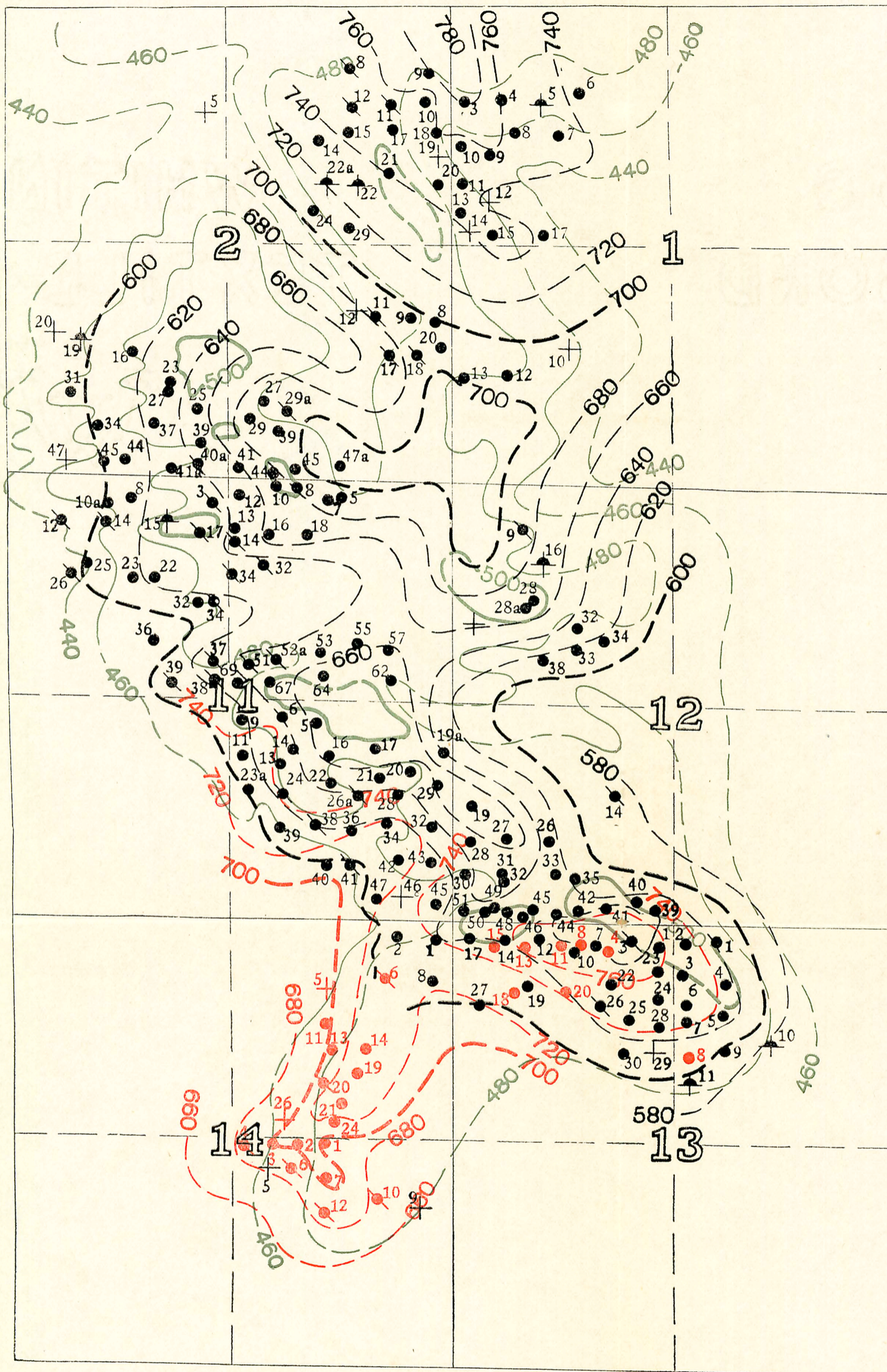

Title: change "red" to "green" and "green" to "red".  
 Legend: transpose legends for red and green contours. In other words, the green contours represent Horizon G, the 500-foot sand, and the red contours represent Horizon J, the 800-foot sand.

The black contours represent the top of the 900-foot sand zone (Horizon K); the green contours the top of the 800-foot sand (Horizon J); and the red contours the top of the 500-foot sand (Horizon G).  
 Only those holes are shown here whose logs gave the elevations of the 300-foot and 900-foot sand zones directly. The additional holes in the pool, chiefly in the 500-foot sand, are shown on Plate XXIII.
