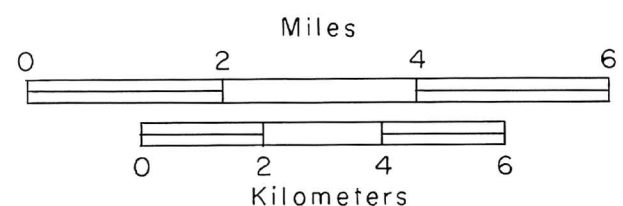


- Diamond-drill hole
  - Drill hole with electrical log
  - Churn-drill hole, water well, etc.
  - ◇ Location approximate (within 1300 feet)
  - ✱ Abandoned coal mine shaft
- A—A' Line of cross section (plates 3 and 4)
  - 200— Contour, interval 20 feet
  - ⊖ Depression contour
  - Boundary of coal
  - — — Boundary of Pennsylvanian
  - Coal locally eroded out

Numbers by datum points indicate elevation relative to mean sea level. "E" indicates elevation computed from known elevation of a higher or lower key member.
