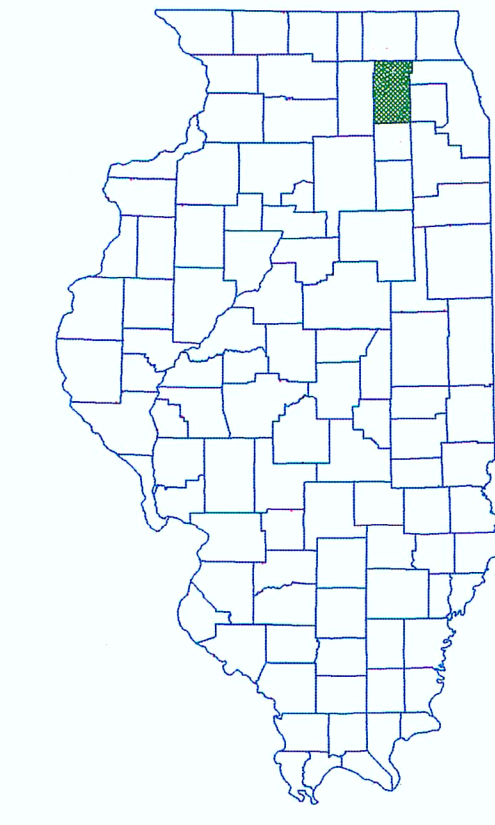




POTENTIAL FOR DEVELOPMENT OF SAND AND GRAVEL RESOURCES

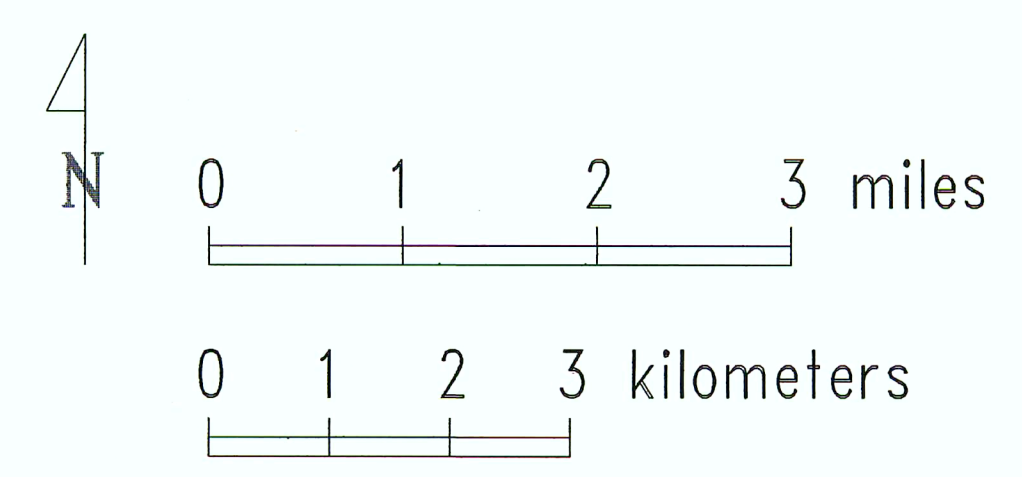

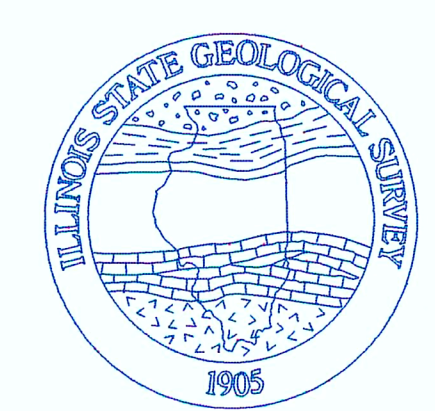
